MEMBERSHIP GUIDELINES (September 2010)

Membership fees

Each choir member is required to pay €5.00 per rehearsal or €50.00 per term.

There are two terms; September to Christmas
January to Easter

Any rehearsals for performances outside of these times must be paid for separately (€5.00 per rehearsal).

This money goes into the choir fund which pays for;

- The rehearsal venue.
- Remuneration for the rehearsal pianist and choral director.
- Insurance.
- Costs involved in staging performances, publicity, etc.

Photocopying

As photocopying of music is a considerable expense for the choir, each member is requested to pay 20c per piece of music taken.

Each member is required to sign for each piece received. (This is to deter people from taking more than one copy which causes problems as the number of copies provided is based on the number of people in the choir).

- So please keep your music in a folder and remember to bring it with you each week !

Attending rehearsals


Each choir member undertakes to attend sufficient rehearsals to familiarise themselves with the programme for performance purposes. For example; I would suggest that a minimum of 7 out of 10 rehearsals should be attended.

An apology for being absent does not qualify as attendance.

Each member must sign in at each rehearsal and no member may sign for another.

The choral director will have the final say in whether or not a member is up to standard for any particular performance.
